Communion Sunday Help Needed: Over the past several years, various lay people have taken turns preparing the Communion elements and assisting in serving Communion. Mitty Johnson has been volunteering to do this over the past several years and is ready to have someone else take a turn. She will be happy to continue to supply the grape juice each month, so the new volunteer will just have to buy the bread and cut it up, prepare the table, serve the elements, and wash the few Communion vessels afterwards. Please speak to Mitty if you can help out with this.

**Recycling:** Many folks seem to be unaware that our church does recycling. If you have # 1 or #2 plastic containers or metal food cans left over from a church activity, please rinse them out and deposit them in one of the beige boxes underneath the big dishwashing sinks. Paper or cardboard, such as your church bulletin, can be placed in the big box just inside the church door next to the food donation box. A blue recycling bin is coming soon to that location to make the paper recycling center more obvious. Thanks for "pitching in" to help our environment.

**Requests for Reimbursements:** If you need our church treasurer to cut you a check, either to reimburse you for money you have fronted for a church project, or to pay a church vendor, you must now fill out a check request form. These are found in a marked envelope in the "Out" box on the door of the church office. A receipt **must** be attached to the form. 

**Treasurer's Notes:** Insurance payment at the beginning of the month, toppped with not getting the anticpated quarterly distribution, made May payroll difficult. Transferred money form another account to cover payroll, then reimbursed that account. Each calendar quarter we have sizable bills; property insurance, workers comp and federal payroll taxes with payroll.

The leadershipp team has explored every existing contract and found ways to save on each. The last contract for conversation is the Amerigas account. On 6/13 the team discussed two options, Ciardelli and L& G Propane. The current tank placement does not meet code. Both vendors quoted a new tank with installation and inspection of the current gas line. The quote from L&G was \$447.00 and did not include fixed pricing. Ciardelli is providing a tank, installation and inspection free of charge with fixed pricing of \$3.499 for this year, a reduction from our current vendor (Amerigas) of \$1.50 per gallon.

The new fridge was charged to the Treasurers credit card, \$869.95 That expense will be reflected in the July report.
